AN ACT to provide for fees and charges levied by Ministries,  
Departments and Agencies and related matters.

DATE OF ASSENT: 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.

PASSED by Parliament and assented to by the President

## *Determination of Fees and Charges*

### **Authority to determine fees and charges**

1. (1) The authority conferred under
  - (a) an enactment set out in the second column of the First Schedule; or
  - (b) any other enactment, to determine fees and charges is transferred to the Minister and accordingly, those enactments are amended.

- (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a fee or charge that is
- (a) determined and fixed by a partnership in accordance with the Public Private Partnership Act, 2020 (Act 1039); and
  - (b) fixed pursuant to the Whistleblower Act, 2006 (Act 720).

**Rate of fees and charges**

2. For a revenue item for a Ministry, a Department or an Agency specified in the First Column of the Second Schedule, the Ministry, Department or Agency may charge the fees specified in the Second Column of the Second Schedule.

*Revision of Fees and Charges*

**Annual adjustment of fees and charges**

3. Subject to the approval of Parliament, the Minister shall annually adjust the fees and charges specified in the Second Schedule in accordance with prevailing economic conditions.

**Review of fees and charges**

4. (1) Despite section 3, the Minister may conduct a periodic review of the fees and charges levied by a Ministry, Department or Agency.

(2) The Minister shall, in conducting the review under subsection (1), have regard to

- (a) an improvement in the quality of service; or
- (b) the relevance of the service; and
- (c) whether the provision of the service should be privatised, partially or entirely.

(3) The Minister may, for the purpose of reviewing fees and charges, cause an audit of the expenditure and revenue of a Ministry, Department or Agency.

*New Fees and Charges*

**Submission of proposed fees and charges**

5. (1) Where an enactment confers authority on a Ministry, Department or Agency to determine fees and charges, the Ministry, Department or Agency shall submit a proposal of the fees and charges to the Minister for consideration.

(2) A newly created Ministry, Department or Agency that is empowered under an enactment to collect fees and charges shall submit proposals for the fees and charges that the Ministry, Department or Agency seeks to collect, to the Minister for consideration.

(3) The Minister shall, on receipt of a proposal for fees and charges from a Ministry, Department or Agency, determine the fees and charges on the basis of overall Government policy.

#### *Miscellaneous Provisions*

#### **Regulations**

6. The Minister may, by legislative instrument, make Regulations to
- (a) amend the First Schedule to include or exclude a Ministry, Department or Agency specified in the First Schedule;
  - (b) amend the First Schedule to include or exclude an enactment;
  - (c) review the fees and charges levied by a Ministry, Department or Agency specified in the Second Schedule; and
  - (d) provide for the effective implementation of this Act.

#### **Interpretation**

7. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,
- “enactment” includes the enactments specified in the First Schedule;
  - “fees and charges” include rates or any moneys charged or levied under an enactment;
  - “Minister” means the Minister responsible for Finance; and
  - “Ministry” means the Ministry responsible for Finance.

#### **Consequential amendment**

8. The Public Financial Management Regulations, 2019 (L.I. 2378) is amended by the revocation of regulation 48.



**Repeal and revocation**

9. (1) The Fees and Charges (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2018 (Act 983) is repealed.

(2) The Fees and Charges (Miscellaneous Provisions) Instrument, 2019 (L.I. 2386) is revoked.
